



DEATH OF A CHILD POLICY

The Nominated Supervisor of the Centre must give notice of the child's death to the following:

- a) Emergency services.
- b) The child's parents.
- c) A member of the Police Force.
- d) Community Services.
- e) The Owners / Approved Provider
- f) The Director General.

Procedure

- a) Staff to re-direct group and call ambulance.
- b) Nominated Supervisor or available staff to administer CPR until ambulance arrives.
- c) Nominated Supervisor to make appropriate phone calls.
- d) Approved Provider / Owner to be notified
- e) Emergency relief staff to be phoned to support-assist daily staff.
(Telephone numbers of emergency helpers is displayed on the staff notice board).

Counselling

For staff and children will be provided for by the Centre.

Reports

Nominated Supervisor must complete a written accident report which is confirmed by other staff and adults present.
